Purpose

The purpose of this financial policy is to describe and document the financial management activities of the EXCO of the International Agricultural Academy for Africa (Pty) Ltd. To accomplish this, the financial policy will be reviewed by the EXCO every year.

Financial year

The financial year for International Agricultural Academy for Africa (Pty) Ltd is from 1 March – 28 February.

Financial Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the Board of Directors (EXCO) to formulate financial policies and review operations and activities every financial year. The EXCO delegates this oversight responsibility to the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) of the International Agricultural Academy for Africa (Pty) Ltd.

Bursary

Annual bursaries can be made available to students of the International Agricultural Academy for Africa (Pty) Ltd, at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors (EXCO). Any student is welcome to apply for a bursary in writing and bursaries will be handled within the Award of Bursaries Policy of the International Agricultural Academy for Africa.

Criteria for a bursary:

- The applicant must be a citizen of South Africa
- The applicant must be interested in a career in the agricultural industry
- The financial circumstances of the applicant will be considered when applying for a bursary
- The applicant must obtain a minimum of 70% in all subjects throughout his/her studies

Financial Policy & Procedures

- A registration fee of **R3,000.00 (Three Thousand Rand)** for the National Certificate and the National Diploma and **R10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Rand)** for the B.Agric Degree, is payable to register for each academic year. This fee is payable before the academic year starts. This registration fee is non-refundable if a student decides not to proceed with studies after registration.
- The academic fees of the International Agricultural Academy for Africa (Pty) Ltd for the 2026 Academic Year are **R30,000.00 (Thirty Thousand Rand)** to study for a one-year National Certificate, and **R60,000 (Sixty Thousand Rand)** to study for a two-year National Diploma.
- The annual tuition fees for the B.Agric programme are as follows: First year, **R55,000.00 (Fifty-Five Thousand Rand)**, second year, **R60,500.00 (Sixty Thousand Five Hundred Rand)**, third year, **R66,550.00 (Sixty-six Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty Rand)**, and the fourth (final) year is **R69,500.00 (Sixty-nine Thousand Five Hundred Rand)**.
- The International Agricultural Academy operates with two intakes annually: the first intake occurs in January, and the second intake takes place in July.
- The academic fees of the International Agricultural Academy for Africa (Pty) Ltd will escalate by 10% each year.
- The student will get a 5% discount if study fees are paid in full before the academic year starts (only applicable to i3A students).
- The student on registration is contractually committed to paying a full semester fee for the academic year. Therefore, if a student decides to discontinue studies within any semester, that student is still responsible to pay the full academic fees for the semester in which the studies were discontinued.
- In the case where a student decides to discontinue their studies a letter has to be signed as evidence of the cancellation. Failure to do so, the student is still responsible to pay for the full academic fees.
- No student can continue with the next year of studies if the academic fees for the previous year are not paid in full.

- When making payments it is compulsory to use your **student number** as the reference. Failure to do so will result in your student account being blocked from the platform and a penalty fee of **R 500.00 (Five Hundred Rand)** will be added to your account.
- Students making use of the Monthly Debit Order Payment Option, will **not be penalised** with the penalty fee and therefore will not be blocked from the platform.
- Monthly Debit Orders are collected at an additional debit order fee of **R200.00 (Two Hundred Rand)** and will be added to your account for each debit order.
- Students making use of the Monthly Debit Order Payment must take responsibility to approve the Debit Order on their bank. It is the responsibility of the person responsible for the student's fees to ensure that Monthly Debit Order Payments occur.
- In the case where payments are not made promptly according to the arrangement by the student on his/her account as according to the payment arrangement selected on the payment options form, such account will be financially blocked from the platform until the next payment is received and reflected on the student's account.
- In the case where payments are not made promptly and the finance department has not received any communication from the student within six months, the student's account will be permanently blocked.
- Payments received will be added to the student's account and financial statement between the 1st and 10th of each month. Payments received during or after this period will result in the payment only reflecting on the student's account in the following month in which the payment was received.
- For each extra qualification/ field of specialisation, an additional fee of **R 9,500.00 (Nine Thousand Five Hundred Rand)** will be charged.
- If a student is applying/ appealing for one or two assessments in a module an additional fee of **R500.00 (Five Hundred Rand)** is payable upfront **per assessment**. If a student is applying to redo a module/ modules during the below-mentioned six-month grace period, no additional fee per module is payable, but the student must be a registered student (pay the registration fee) for the specific academic year.
- When studies are not completed within the specific qualification's timeframe, a student must apply in writing to be granted an additional six-month (One semester) period free of charge of any additional academic fees, to enable the student to complete all arrear assignments within these six months. If such arrear qualification/s are not completed within the six-month (One semester) period following the official date set for the completion of the qualification, an additional **R 8,500.00 (Eight Thousand Five Hundred Rand)** is payable per semester that it may take the student to complete his/her studies.

- The person responsible for the student's account must sign the payment options form.

Mandate

- The person responsible for the debit order payment must complete the mandate with their full account name as stated on the bank, the name of the bank and branch code, their bank account number, and a full ID number & cellphone number.
- All mandates must be signed by the person responsible for the student's account.
